

SMSA SNOWPLOWING PROCEDURES

- 1. Snow is plowed when 4" has accumulated.
- 2. If the roads are icy, gravel or sand will be added to those areas.
- 3. The snowplow <u>travels the roads twice</u> during each call to plow, pushing the snow back as far as possible, plus some work on the intersections.
- 4. The snowplow will use a rubber edge to save our gravel.
- 5. <u>If it snows all day long</u>, the snowplow may wait until snowing stops, unless it looks to be getting too deep to handle in which case, multiple plowings will be made.
- 6. <u>Ice on steep areas:</u> Gravel or sand will be added to the three hills as needed
 - a. Sundance,
 - b. Blue Smoke and
 - c. at the end of Shotgun Spring Rd.
- 7. <u>Gravel bins</u> are place in 3 locations by steep areas. <u>These should be monitored and kept filled.</u>
- 8. Roads will be plowed to the exact locations of the 6 shared wells.
 - a. Often overlooked areas are those wells at the ends of private driveways. We ask members to contact smsaroads@gmail.com or call the hotline at 740-339-7510 if those areas have not been plowed.
- 9. <u>Watching the weather advisory.</u> SMSAROADS will contact the snow plowers to discuss and evaluate the report and have them provide recommendations for handling each situation.
